Meet Chase, a 15-year old Ojibwe Pony stallion who is visiting at Sagehill Stables

The Ojibwe Pony, also known as the Lac LaCroix Pony or Indian Pony, is a breed developed by Indigenous people in the Boreal Forest regions of Canada and the northern U.S. It is a spirit animal for Indigenous people and it is listed as a critically endangered breed in Canada.

What the tour includes:

- Meet Chase and see where he lives
- Learn all about Chase and his ancestors from one of the Spirit Horse Project volunteers
- Run with Stars book reading, written by Chase's owner Darcy Whitecrow
- Pet Chase and see up-close all the cool features that make him different from our present-day horse breeds
- Q&A with volunteers about the Ojibwe Horse breed and breeding projects
